## How is TruckSafe different from other safety management systems?

## Animal Welfare

The TruckSafe animal welfare standard is the only risk mitigation tool for animal welfare compliance. The standard exceeds all requirements of the Land Transport Standards and best practice expectations of producers, processors, retailers and consumers.



### Responsibilities and Planning

Accredited transporters have documented systems for risk management, tracking and tracing, livestock identification and contingency planning.

### Vehicles and Facilities

Animal transport vehicles and facilities for holding, loading and unloading are designed, constructed, maintained and operated to minimise distress or discomfort to livestock.

### Pre-Transport Selection of Livestock

Livestock prepared and selected for transport are assessed to ensure they are fit for the intended journey and that action is taken with regard to livestock deemed unfit to load.

### Loading, Transporting and Unloading

Livestock are handled, loaded, transported and unloaded in a manner that minimises risks to animal welfare including managing stocking densities, access to feed/water, observation of animals and identification of ill or diseased livestock.

### Handling Livestock

Ensures all personnel involved in transporting animals are skilled, experienced, trained and appropriately inducted.
